

From the Director

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As a non-profit, NPACE works hard in to give back to the NP community through excellent continuing education and opportunities. Without requiring membership we ensure our content is accessible to any NP. We are proud to note that in 2022 thus far we are able to provide significant giveback in our educational offerings! Below are just a few of the ways we are able to provide continuing education content:

- Thus far, we have provided partner courses each month to over 300 learners totaling over 2,100 registrants.
- Through our work with partner organizations we were able to provide two free continuing education webinars with partners to over 250 registrants.
- Through internal grant funding we provided 2,310 free NPACE developed program registrations totaling over 10,000 credit hours in our learning center.
- In working with partners and through grant funding we have been able to provide over 2 additional continuing education credits at every live event in 2022
- NPACE also proudly provides a faculty program, where up to 5 free seats are given to full-time NP faculty at each conference. In 2022 NPACE filled all of our faculty seats at each event. To learn more about our full-time faculty program see information [here](#).
- We launched a free [cardiac foundations program](#), in conjunction with Dr. Midge Bowers, based in new nurse practitioner and student NP learning needs with 4.75 CE hours.
